- The final destination for each bus is displayed on the front of the vehicle.
- The first stop for the Georgetown bound bus at Union Station is located on the bus level of the parking garage. Buses stop in the garage for a short layover. Passengers may also board this route at the NW corner of Massachusetts Avenue and North Capitol Street to avoid the layover.
