



### Know Your Quadrants!

Washington is divided into four quadrants. Many street names and intersections exist in more than one quadrant. Check the full address of your destination to be sure that you are off to the right quadrant!

**Metrobus Routes**

- A2** Metrobus Major Route: Frequent, seven-day service on the core route. On branches, service levels vary.
- A4** Metrobus Local Route: Less frequent service, with some evening and weekend service available.
- X3** Metrobus Commuter Route: Weekday peak-hour service linking residential areas to Metrorail stations and employment centers.
- S9** MetroExtra Route: Limited stops for a faster ride. Days, times and service levels vary by route.
- SA** Metrobus Airport Express Route: Limited stop service to Dulles International Airport.

**Bus Routes**

- Major Route**: For all service providers, frequent, seven-day service on the core route is denoted by a thick line. On branches, service levels vary.
- DC Circulator**
- The Bus - Prince George's County**
- Ride On - Montgomery County**

On all route types, a lowlighted badge indicates a route segment with limited or peak-only service hours.

### Additional Services

**Outside of Metrorail Service Hours**

- S93** Follows Route 90-92 and travels to Congress Heights via Stanton Rd SE.
- A11** Follows Route A12 in Prince George's County and then operates to Federal Triangle.
- A42** Follows Route A2 in Anacostia and then operates to/from Archives via M St SE/SW.
- A46** Follows Route A6 in Anacostia and then operates to/from Archives via M St SE/SW.
- A48** Follows Route A8 in Anacostia and then operates to/from Archives via M St SE/SW.
- J13** Follows Route J12 in Prince George's County then operates to Potomac Ave.
- K11** Follows Route K12 in Prince George's County then operates to/from Potomac Ave.
